Dear Secretary Dortch:

On March 26, 2015, the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) adopted an Order approving the recommendation of the North American Numbering Council (NANC) that Telcordia Technologies, Inc., d/b/a iconectiv (Telcordia) serve as the next local number portability administrator (LNPA).¹ The Order directed the North American Portability Management, LLC (NAPM LLC), with Commission oversight, to negotiate the terms of a Master Services Agreement or MSA with Telcordia. The Order further provided for the MSA, a Voting Trust, and a Code of Conduct relating to neutrality to be submitted to the Commission for review and approval.² The NAPM LLC, by its attorneys, hereby submits, with the approval of Telcordia, the MSA to the Commission for review and approval. The MSA, the entirety of which constitutes Confidential Information or Highly Confidential Information, has been designated and stamped, and is hereby submitted, in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Second Protective Order adopted earlier today by the Commission.³ In addition, two copies of each Stamped Confidential Document and Stamped Highly Confidential Document and the accompanying cover letter are being


