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I oppose unnecessary set-top box regulations that will drive up our TV bills while giving us fewer choices, less privacy, and more advertisements on TV.

The TV market today is full of great choices and innovation, from Amazon to Apple TV, Chromecast to Hulu and more, and new products and services are coming out every day. Yet your proposed mandate will require new devices and network changes consumers will have to pay for - without bringing any new programs or features to TV. Why put a healthy market at risk with costly and unnecessary new rules?

Any company that wants to start a video service or sell a video device can already do so - like Amazon and TiVo and many others. The FCC should not use its power to give a shortcut to anyone, especially when consumers will end up footing the bill. Please do not adopt these rules.
