On April 4, 2016, representatives of Charter Communications, Inc. (“Charter”), Time Warner Cable Inc. (“TWC”), and Advance/Newhouse Partnership (“Advance/Newhouse”) (collectively, the “Applicants”) met with Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) staff copied at the bottom of this letter. Participating for Charter were: Catherine Bohigian, Alex Hoehn-Saric, Christianna Barnhart, and Audrey Connors; and Sam Feder, Leah Tulin, and the undersigned of Jenner & Block. Also participating were Matt Brill of Latham & Watkins and Steven Teplitz for TWC; and Steven Horvitz of Davis Wright Tremaine on behalf of Advance/Newhouse.

During the meeting, representatives for Charter discussed New Charter’s commitments, including settlement-free interconnection under the company’s interconnection policy, CableCARD support, broadband service without usage-based pricing or data caps, the expansion of New Charter’s broadband network to new customer locations, the offer of a low-cost broadband service, and how the Commission could enforce these commitments.
