**PAY TEL COMMUNICATIONS, INC.
WITHDRAWAL OF PARTIAL OBJECTION TO TELMATE, LLC’S
REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION**

Pay Tel Communications, Inc., (“Pay Tel”), by its attorneys, hereby withdraws its partial objection¹ to the request of counsel for Telmate, LLC (“Telmate”)² to obtain access to the unredacted version of the Second Report and Order and Third Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (“Second Report and Order”)³ released in this proceeding.

The Partial Objection objected to any disclosure by the Commission of Pay Tel’s Confidential Information to Telmate’s counsel prior to resolution of the pending objections filed by Telmate⁴ and two other ICS providers⁵ (collectively, the “ICS Provider Objections”) to

receipt by Pay Tel's outside counsel of the same information. Since Pay Tel's filing of the Partial Objection, the Commission has resolved the ICS Providers' Objections in Pay Tel's favor.⁶

As such, Pay Tel now withdraws its Partial Objection.
