On April 4, 2016, Patrick Welsh and Max Solondz (via telephone) of Verizon met with Brian Regan, Paul Powell, Chris Helzer, and Matthew Pearl of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Ira Keltz of the Office of Engineering and Technology regarding the above-referenced matter.

During the meeting, Verizon described the importance of allowing Priority Access License ("PAL") holders to define service areas and protection contours when registering with an affiliated Spectrum Access System ("SAS"). We also discussed the ongoing work of the Winn Forum to develop protocols for SAS registration of PALs and General Authorized Access users. Our discussion was consistent with the attached presentation.
