Life in rural America can be different than in other parts of the country: my parents and brother (all farmers/ranchers) do not have internet access, so their access to information directly relevant to their business comes from RFD-TV and newspapers/magazines specifically focused on agriculture. The number of sources of this information is quite limited, and RFD-TV provides a necessary function for the agricultural industry. Limiting availability of their program would restrict access of this information to people who don't have it easily available through another source. I strongly suggest that you continue to allow access to this programming to the entire agricultural audience.
