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I urge the Commission to push through with the expansion of Video Description provided and to go further still. Every channel that has SAP or alternate audio technology should be providing Description to offer full Accessible Media (Captioning + Description) to all consumers with sensory disabilities. And with Netflix embracing Description, the FCC should be more aggressive in requiring other such streaming apps and websites to also include Description. This is especially so for those channels that are already covered by the CVAA's mandate. With the difficulties experienced by blind consumers navigating cable boxes, every outlet available should be made as accessible as possible so that the audience this service is intended for actually can experience and enjoy it. Further they should be able to enjoy their favorite programs with the freedom and availability that sighted users now take for granted.
