Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 8, 2016, Reed Hundt, counsel to Ligado Networks, and the undersigned met with Jon Wilkins, Charles Mathias, and Brian Regan from the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and with Ron Repasi from the Office of Engineering & Technology. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the license modification applications filed in December 2015 and the pending rulemaking request for reallocation to shared use of the band at 1675-1680 MHz. The parties discussed how Ligado has worked diligently and continues to do so to reach an understanding regarding its network deployment with all stakeholders as well as with the Commission to enable this vital mid-band spectrum to be put to use and promote 5G and benefit the public. The parties stated that issuance of a public notice related to the issues raised in the license modification applications and the rulemaking petition would provide all interested parties the opportunity to comment on the new power limits and the company's plans for terrestrial deployment and how these limitations will benefit all consumer GPS devices.
