Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 19, 2016, Stacey Black of AT&T and Jennifer A. Manner of EchoStar Satellite Operating Corporation, Hughes Network Systems, LLC and Alta Wireless, Inc. (collectively “EchoStar”) met with Daudeline Meme of Commissioner Clyburn’s office.

In this meeting, AT&T and EchoStar reviewed their proposed framework for sharing the 28 GHz band and the 37.0-40.0 GHz band among Fixed-Satellite Service licensees (“FSS”) and new Upper Microwave Flexible Use (“UMFU”) licensees. We discussed the framework’s three primary goals: 1) protect existing FSS licensees and provide them co-primary status with new UMFU licensees; 2) establish protection zones in the urban cores of key metropolitan areas to prevent potential interference to UMFU systems from new FSS installations; and 3) establish a set of coordination guidelines and parameters that allows FSS and UMFU licensees to fairly share the spectrum outside of the protection zones.

While details of the coordination, safe harbor and aggregate interference guidelines are still being developed, AT&T and EchoStar believe that this framework will enable both satellite and mobile services to make intensive and productive use of these valuable spectrum resources in a manner that does not unduly restrict the development of either service.
