More independent sources for video programming need to be made available so that marginalized populations are equally represented through programming. Quality programming should be as diverse as its viewers. There is little to no representation for or from the disability community on the issue of promoting the availability of diverse and independent sources of video programming. This needs to change. More importantly, there remains underrepresentation of the disability community in mainstream TV, and an even greater absence of programming for individuals of color with disabilities. The disability community is continuously underrepresented in mainstream television. Creating opportunities for more independent sources of video programming will increase the chance to develop programming that will ensure that those of us in the disability community are fairly represented through diverse programming.
