On April 19, 2016, Chris Murphy, Associate General Counsel, Regulatory Affairs, ViaSat, Inc. and the undersigned counsel to ViaSat, Inc. met with Elizabeth Andrion, Acting Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis (“OSP”) and the other representatives from OSP listed below (with some participating by telephone). We described ViaSat’s current 25/3 Mbps service offering and its forthcoming ViaSat 2 and recently announced ViaSat 3 satellites. Those satellites, which be available in 2017 and 2019, respectively, will significantly increase the capacity and throughput of the ViaSat broadband network, as described in recent filings.

We also emphasized ViaSat’s support for an objective, and competitively neutral, market-based mechanism that distributes CAF support to the lowest cost bidder and briefly discussed ViaSat’s April 14 and February 2, 2016 submissions in these proceedings.
