I'm writing to express my support for the proposal to unlock the monopoly on Cable Boxes. It's long overdue and the monopoly is hindering competition and technological advancement. Even more pressing is the cost to consumers. I've been a DirecTV customer for 10 years paying monthly lease fees every month. Last year I bought a new Samsung TV that had RVU technology. RVU was a built in DirecTV tuner that works with the Whole Home DVR and eliminates the need for a set top box. I was excited at the prospect of not needing a set top box or pay the lease fees. When I upgraded my TV I also upgraded my DirecTV receivers so I could use the RVU tuner built into my TV. I had two DirecTV DVR's and upgraded to the GENIE whole home system. The Genie upgrade was a set cost and I had to option to keep my DVR's or return them, it was my choice. I opted for the Genie main receiver and two wireless Genie Mini's as well as the RVU tuner in my TV. I returned the two DVR's. Unfortunately, the first disappointment was DirecTV actually charged me a lease fee on the RVU tuner in my own TV. They called it something else but it was essentially a lease fee. The RVU tuner was also buggy and not ready for prime time. Everytime I turned my TV on is said device not authorized. I had to do a hard reset of my genie tuner so it could connect. It would lag and the audio would trail out of sync with the video. It would freeze when trying to Fast Forward. I worked with DirecTV for a couple of weeks and they couldn't resolve the issue. It had been less than 30 days since I returned my original DVR's and I ask to get one of them back since the RVU didn't work. DirecTV said I would have to pay for a new DVR since I had already returned the other one. The new DVR was the same model as the one I returned, no improvements or upgrades and I had to pay to get the same box back I already paid for. I refused to do that so I just hooked up one of the wireless tuners to my TV. Even though I had paid for the two DVR's, and paid the lease fee every month for two years, they refused to return one to me and wanted me to pay \$200 to get the same box back again. Forcing customers to pay \$100s of dollars up front and monthly lease fees for cable boxes are an unnecessary burden for consumers. Cable boxes are big bulky old and unnecessary hardware based technology. Software based technology is already prevalent and comes preinstalled on TV's and devices like Netflix, Amazon, Hulu. The technology exists to move to software based encryption and save consumers hundreds of dollars a year. Please end the monopoly on set top boxes and let competition drive prices down.
