Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 21, 2016, Chris Murphy, Associate General Counsel, Regulatory Affairs, and Daryl Hunter, Senior Director, Regulatory Affairs of ViaSat, Inc. (“ViaSat”), and the undersigned counsel to ViaSat, Inc., met with Diane Cornell and Edward Smith of Chairman Wheeler’s office. ViaSat’s approach to sharing between FSS satellite operations and 5G in the 27.5-28.35 GHz and 37.5-40 GHz frequency bands, as described in ViaSat’s *ex parte* submission filed in the above-referenced proceedings on April 21, 2016, formed the basis for the conversation.

ViaSat emphasized again that it is working with all interested parties to find a way forward based on mutual technical cooperation to allow *all* services to grow in the future, consistent with the Chairman’s directive at the March Spectrum Frontiers Workshop that sharing is “a two-way street” and his “hope that the satellite industry and the mobile industry would get together and work on how they can coexist because the future of spectrum in the 21st century is a future of sharing” and that “there are expectations on the mobile industry to meet the satellite interests in a fair and open and equal manner.”¹
