On April 25, 2016, I spoke with Diane Cornell, Special Counsel, Office of the Chairman, Rebekah Goodheart, Legal Advisor to Comm. Clyburn, and Travis Litman, Legal Advisor to Comm. Rosenworcel, and left a voicemail message for Amy Bender, Legal Advisor to Comm. O’Rielly, with respect to the document placed in the record today by the Office of the General Counsel, which was a copy of a complaint filed in New Jersey Superior Court in the case of Michael Stern v. Telcordia Technologies, et al. I informed the FCC individuals with whom I spoke that Telcordia had investigated the plaintiff’s allegations of non-compliance with certain obligations, and had found them to be meritless. Specifically, Telcordia’s investigation concluded that the individuals hired during the time in question met all applicable obligations. Telcordia is committed to upholding its obligations, and takes seriously any allegations with respect to those obligations. Telcordia strongly disputes all the allegations in the complaint, and believes it will be vindicated in court.
