On April 25, 2016, I spoke with Diane Cornell, Special Counsel, Office of the Chairman, Rebekah Goodheart, Legal Advisor to Comm. Clyburn, and Travis Litman, Legal Advisor to Comm. Rosenworcel, and left a voicemail message for Amy Bender, Legal Advisor to Comm. O’Rielly. On April 26, 2016, I spoke with Nicholas Degani, Legal Advisor to Comm. Pai.

I informed the FCC participants that the North American Portability Management, LLC was filing a “Redacted for Public Inspection” version of the Master Services Agreement with Telcordia and exhibits. I also stated that Telcordia was filing an opposition to Neustar’s Application for Review, which is meritless. The Commission has a long history of balancing public access and the protection of proprietary information through protective orders. Moreover, the Second Protective Order’s additional safeguards for security information are appropriate and well within the Commission’s discretion. In the conversation with Mr. Degani, I also discussed the matters summarized in my ex parte of April 25.<sup>1</sup>
