Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 22, 2016, Chris Murphy, Associate General Counsel, Regulatory Affairs, ViaSat, Inc. and the undersigned counsel to ViaSat, Inc. met with Stephanie Weiner, Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Wheeler, and Alex Minard, Deputy Chief of the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, regarding Phase II of the CAF. We described ViaSat's current 25/3 Mbps service offering and its forthcoming ViaSat 2 and recently announced ViaSat 3 satellites. Those satellites, which will be available in 2017 and 2019, respectively, will significantly increase the capacity and throughput of the ViaSat broadband network, as described in recent filings.

We also emphasized ViaSat's support for an objective, and competitively neutral, market-based mechanism that distributes CAF support to the lowest cost bidder and briefly discussed ViaSat's April 14 and February 2, 2016 submissions in these proceedings.
