Wilson Telephone Company, Inc. dba Wilson Communications (“Wilson”) hereby provides notice that it intends to cease offering wireline broadband internet access service on a tariffed basis. Effective July 1, 2016 Wilson will begin offering wireline broadband internet access service on a Title II, common carriage, permissive detariffed basis pursuant to paragraph 94 of the Federal Communications Commission’s Wireline Broadband Order.<sup>1</sup> The geographic area affected is the entire Wilson study area.

Today, this service is provided to Wilson Communication Company, Inc. (“WCC”), an affiliated ISP. WCC purchases wireline broadband access service for use as a component in its broadband internet service sold to residential and business consumers. End user service provided will not be affected by discontinuance of the tariffed offering by Wilson. As stated in the attached customer notice, Wilson will continue to offer services to existing ISP customers under current rates, terms and conditions until the end of the current term or upon replacement with a commercial Broadband agreement. These agreements will be made available in a nondiscriminatory manner to any provider desiring to purchase wireline broadband access service for use as a component in its broadband internet service sold to consumers.

Effective July 1, 2016, Wilson will make its wireline broadband internet access service available on a permissive detariffed, common carriage basis through the posting of rates, terms, and conditions available on our company website ([www.wilsoncommunications.us](http://www.wilsoncommunications.us)) and in printed copy during normal business hours at Wilson’s business office located at 2504 Avenue D, Wilson, KS 67490.

Our records indicate that Wilson Communication Company, Inc. is currently purchasing wholesale broadband transport services from Wilson Telephone Company, Inc. under NECA Tariff No. 5 ("Tariff"). This letter is to advise you that Wilson Telephone Company, Inc. (study area 411849) will discontinue provisioning service on July 1, 2016, pursuant to the Tariff. Services will be made available to you on a common carrier, non-tariffed basis. The existing relevant rates, terms, and conditions will not change until the end of your term or upon replacement with a commercial Broadband agreement. Details of Wilson Telephone Company, Inc.'s non-tariffed wireline broadband Internet access service offering including rates, terms, and conditions will be made available during regular business hours at Wilson's primary place of business at 2504 Avenue D, Wilson, KS 67490 and on its website at [www.wilsoncommunications.us](http://www.wilsoncommunications.us).

The actions described above are taken in accordance with the FCC's Report and Order (FCC 05-150) released September 23, 2005 in Docket No. 02-33. In the order, the FCC determined that facilities-based wireline broadband Internet service providers could offer their services on a common carrier, permissively detariffed basis.
