Common today are so-called QRP rigs that are capable of 10 watts or less. These are fine for mobile work or for working as a low power station. However, many owners of these rigs would also like to work long distance (DX) communications without having to purchase an entire new transmitter/transceiver.

Currently they would have to purchase an intermediate amplifier and then connect that to a power amplifier capable of full legal output. That is just plain silly.
