

On April 25, 2016, Scott Meyer, Chief Executive Officer, and Todd Ruback, Chief Privacy Officer and VP, Legal Affairs, of Ghostery, and Lydia Parnes and Chris Olsen of Wilson Sonsini Goodrich & Rosati, met with Matt DelNero, Lisa Hone, Melissa Kirkel, Sherwin Siy, Scott Jordan, Bakari Middleton, and David Brody of the Wireline Competition Bureau, and Jennifer Tatel of the Office of General Counsel.
