On April 27, 2016, Tom Rutledge, President and Chief Executive Officer of Charter Communications, Inc., spoke by telephone with Commissioner O’Rielly; Catherine Bohigian, Charter’s Executive Vice President for Government Affairs, spoke by telephone with Commissioner Pai; and I spoke by telephone with Matthew Berry, Chief of Staff to Commissioner Pai, on Charter’s behalf. In addition, on April 29, 2016, Ms. Bohigian and I met with Mr. Berry and Marc Paul, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Rosenworcel. Also on April 29, Ms. Bohigian, Alex Hoehn-Saric, Charter’s Senior Vice President for Government Affairs, and I met with Commissioner O’Rielly and his Legal Advisor, Erin McGrath.

During these conversations, Charter urged approval of the Transaction, and explained that the Transaction will deliver numerous public interest benefits, including increased network buildout, faster broadband service, and an industry-leading low-income broadband offer. Charter also explained that, contrary to the claims of the Transaction’s opponents, the Transaction will have no corresponding negative impact on consumers.
