I am respectfully submitting this comment and endorsement of the Charter-Time Warner Cable merger on behalf of my clients Uphoric TV, the only network fully dedicated to music festivals, and Dog TV, the only network designed by animal behaviorists for dogs, both independent cable channels.

We commend Charter for their commitment to localism and for providing content, including independent channels, that benefit their customers, that meet their customer demands and that provide their customers options for diverse programming.

On the music front, we applaud Charter for their support of local artists and music festivals and for providing DVDs to the troops overseas for five years running.

On the animal welfare front, we commend Charter for recognizing the passion their customers have for their pets (over \$70 billion is spent annually on the pet industry in the US) and for supporting initiatives such as pet adoptions and other pet friendly programming and services.
