On May 5, 2016, Louie Holmes, CEO, Mix Networks, Charles Land, Executive Director, Texttel, Mary Lohnes, Regulatory Affairs Manager, MIDCO, Robert McCausland, VP, Regulatory and Government Affairs, West, Arno Vigen, CFO, Airespring, Inc., and the undersigned participated on a call with Diane Cornell, Special Counsel to Chairman Wheeler, Kris Monteith, Ann Stevens, and Sanford Williams of the Wireline Competition Bureau and Terry Cavanaugh, with the Office of the General Counsel, to discuss concerns about the perceived rush to approve the iconectiv Master Service Agreement (MSA) currently before the Commission.

The Parties expressed their desire to ensure that the companies who were unable to participate in NAPM LLC due to its \$34,000 membership fee now have the time to review the MSA. The Parties concerns included the lack of any assurance that the industry will not see major increases in costs to access NPAC, lack of contractual requirements for iconectiv to provide needed IP interfaces, and concerns about a seamless LNPA Transition free of any unnecessary costs or disruptions to services.

Participants from the FCC offered input to The Parties questions and referred to an Ex Parte filing due to come out the next day as a source for answers to some of these questions. There was also a discussion of the importance of timing for the transition.
