

This letter is in response to process #12-267. Without having to review what has been published and that you are well aware of, I am wanting to show my opposition. The cost that is going to be associated to my company is going to be approx \$50,000 dollars. As a mobile uplink company our trucks are always manned when transmitting, with phone communications. A CID ruling or lack of exception for my field is not warranted. The intent is to decrease or eliminate interference. and since we check in and have communication with the satellite operations center, that has been accomplished. This type of unjustified and unwarranted targeting of a market sector is counter productive to our industry.

I also would like to point out, as I am sure you are aware, that CID is being used as a major revenue source for the industry. My 5 year old Tandberg SM 6620 modulators have just been declared end of life for service, just in time for CID. Many other manufactures have also done the same type of tactic and should not be allowed to proceed.
