Farming was our way of life and only RFD-TV keeps us informed + entertained.


Every Sat. night a group goes out to eat + then goes home to watch Molly B.


I am writing to you regarding the 16-41 Proceeding (RFD-TV). It is important to have quality television programs, especially television programs that the entire family can watch.






