Dear FCC, Proceeding No. 16-41:

It is a serious mistake for a cable company such as Comcast to discontinue the viewing of RFD-TV to city or urban areas. Citizens residing in these areas need to be exposed to the important agricultural way of life to appreciate the farmer and where their food originates. The general concept held by many city folks that all food originates in grocery stores needs to be dispelled. One U.S. farmer produces enough food annually to feed an estimated 200 or more people. The food is of the highest quality, safest and most economical in the world.

Having grown-up on a dairy farm, I watch RFD-TV and am amazed at the new and remarkable advances in the agricultural and veterinary medical sciences which are also important for city dwellers to know about. RFD-TV provides excellent information about the prevention, treatment and control of livestock diseases. Over 100 are transmitted to animals as well as human-beings. From a public health aspect, it is educational for the urban citizen.

Farmers not only provide our daily food supply for the dinner table, they also produce grain for ethanol production so all of us can use it in the gasoline for driving our automobiles. This is another example of the importance of the agricultural sciences that our citizens needs to appreciate.

In summary, I urge the FCC to react on the side of equanimity in your decision against banning RFD-TV for urban viewers. In my opinion, RFD-TV serves an important role in providing outstanding information for both rural and urban citizens.


