Though no longer required for a Ham Radio License, CW/Morse Code is still heavily used on the Ham Bands. Even a casual listener will find the CW portions of the Bands busy with numerous signals, even when the SSB portions are silent. At poor propagation times, this is especially noted. Additionally, the obvious interference with SSB signals close to CW signals is another can of worms not needed. Furthermore, if something isn't broke, don't try to fix it. It seems this proposal is more because of an individual's "axe to grind" than one to further the cause of Ham Radio and Band Allocations. I strongly oppose this filing/proposal of RM-11769.
