I oppose the petition. There is no reason to have to create a new communications classification (e.g. symbol communications). Permitting data transmissions with a 20dB bandwidth of 2800 Hz throughout the non-voice segments of the 3.5-30 MHz spectrum could be a significant source of interference for narrow-band modes. The petitioner's case is non-compelling. It appears to be a solution to a non-existent problem.
