I am writing to comment against this proposal. The CW bands are necessary to be left as is with separate protection from SSB and other methods of phone interference. CW is used by many amateurs of all classes especially for transmission of important messages between areas of the country. This communication is performed in regularly scheduled nets listed with the ARRL and they need protection against phone interference. Most weekends and much of each days during the week is busy in the CW bands used for local as well as worldwide communications. Interference from phone operation would negate most of these communications especially for those of us that operate with power limited to much less than the maximum allowed. Byron W.
