I oppose the proposal for the elimination of CW sub-bands. The amount of bandwidth dedicated to them is small, and has no significant impact on the overall available bandwidth for other modes, in my opinion.

CW is still a strong and vital part of amateur radio, and an important mode for communication with a minimum of infrastructure and technical overhead world-wide. Other narrowband modes, such as digital modes, are likely to create a significant interference problem for CW operators if the sub-band is eliminated.
