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The marketplace for video content is roaring and highly competitive, offering a diverse array of video streaming services, cloud-based video on demand, and apps providing news, movies and programming. This market is quickly innovating beyond the traditional set-top box to new applications and devices with more choices than ever.

Past Commission attempts to govern set-top boxes have been a complete failure. Yet another failed attempt at heavy-handed government regulation will only put the brakes on innovation and benefit companies with political influence rather than companies that provide what viewers want. We don't need the federal government to attempt to fix what isn't broken -- I urge you to reject the proposed rule.
