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The market for video content is booming and extremely competitive, offering a wide array of video streaming services, cloud-based video on demand, and apps providing news, films and programming. This market is quickly innovating beyond the traditional set-top box to new applications and devices with more options than ever.

Past Commission attempts to govern set-top boxes have been a complete failure. Yet another failed attempt at one-size-fits-all government regulation will only hinder innovation and benefit companies with political influence rather than companies that provide what consumers want. We don't need the federal government to repair something what isn't broken -- I urge you to reject the proposed rule.
