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The marketplace for video content is thriving and incredibly competitive, offering a diverse array of video streaming services, cloud-based video on demand, and apps providing news, films and programming. This market is rapidly innovating beyond the traditional set-top box to new applications and devices with more diversity than ever. Past Commission attempts to control set-top boxes have been a complete failure. Yet another failed attempt at one-size-fits-all government regulation will only hinder innovation and benefit companies with political influence rather than companies that provide what consumers want. We don't need the FCC to repair something what isn't broken -- I urge you to reject the proposed rule.
