On Thursday, May 19, 2016, I spoke on behalf of the North American Portability Management LLC (the "NAPM LLC") with Diane Cornell, Special Counsel, regarding the need for the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission"):

- promptly to approve the Master Services Agreement between the NAPM LLC and Telcordia Technologies, Inc. d/b/a iconectiv ("iconectiv") (the "New MSA"); and
- to deny Neustar, Inc.'s Application for Review of the Wireline Competition Bureau's ("Bureau") March 31, 2016 Second Protective Order.<sup>1</sup>

The reasons we discussed for taking these actions are fully described in the ex parte letter that the NAPM LLC filed on May 6, 2016 in the above-referenced proceedings.
