Plainview Telephone company, Inc. hereby provides notice that it intends to cease offering wireline broadband internet access service on a tariffed basis. Effective July 1, 2016 Plainview Telephone Company, Inc. will begin offering wireline broadband internet access service on a Title II, common carrier, permissive detariffed basis pursuant to paragraph 94 of the Federal Communications Commission's Wireline Broadband Order.<sup>1</sup> The geographic area affected is the Plainview Telephone Company, Inc. exchange where DSL is technically feasible.

Today, this service is provided to Plainview Telephone Company, Inc. The ISP purchases wireline broadband access service for use as a component in their broadband internet service sold to residential and business consumers. End user service provided will not be affected by discontinuance of the tariffed offering by Plainview Telephone Company, Inc. As stated in the attached customer notice Plainview Telephone Company, Inc. will continue to offer services to existing ISP customers under current rates, terms and conditions until the end of their current term or upon replacement with a Broadband Commercial Agreement. Broadband Commercial Agreements will be made available in a nondiscriminatory manner to any provider desiring to purchase wireline broadband access service for use as a component in it broadband internet service sold to consumers.

Effective July 1, 2016 Plainview Telephone Company, Inc. will make its wireline broadband internet access service on a permissive detariffed, common carrier basis through posting of rates, terms and conditions available on our company website ([www.plvwtelco.net](http://www.plvwtelco.net)) and in printed copy during normal business hours at Plainview Telephone Company, Inc. business office located at 112 South Main St. Plainview NE 68769

Our records indicate that Nyecom Teleservices, Inc. is currently purchasing wholesale broadband transport services from Plainview Telephone Company Inc. under NECA Tariff No. 5 ("Tariff"). This letter is to advise you that Plainview Telephone Company, Inc. study area 371582 will discontinue provisioning service on July 1, 2016 pursuant to the Tariff. Services will be made available to you on a common carrier, non-tariffed basis. The existing relevant rates, terms and conditions will not change until the end of your term or until replaced by a Broadband Commercial Agreement.

The rates, terms and conditions for the Broadband Commercial Agreement will be available in printed copy during normal business hours at Plainview Telephone Company, Inc. business office located at 112 South Main Street, Plainview NE 68769.

The actions described above are taken in accordance with the FCC's Report and Order (FCC05-150) released September 23, 2005 in Docket No. 02-33. In this order the FCC determined that facilities-based wireline broadband internet service providers could offer their services on a common carrier, permissively detariffed basis.
