MOTION TO ACCEPT REPLY COMMENTS

Zoom Telephonics, Inc. (Zoom) respectfully asks that the Commission accept the formatted pdf version of its reply comments dated May 23, 2016 in this proceeding, Docket 16-42. Reply comments in this proceeding were due on May 23, 2016. Zoom made repeated unsuccessful attempts to upload the reply comments to the Commission's ECFS system on that day, but the system was evidently not fully functional. Accordingly, Zoom instead submitted an unformatted text version of the reply comments via the Commission's ECFS Express system. Zoom was able to upload a formatted pdf version of the reply comments on May 24, 2016, and asks that they be accepted and substituted for the unformatted text version.

On May 24, 2016, the Commission's ECFS Help Desk confirmed to counsel for Zoom that the ECFS system had been overloaded on May 23, 2016 and was not accepting submissions at various times during the day.

Accordingly, Zoom asks that the Commission accept the formatted pdf version of its reply comments dated May 23, 2016 but not submitted until May 24, 2016 and grant all such other relief as may be just and proper.
