**PETITION FOR WAIVER OF INVOICE EXTENSION DEADLINE for FUNDING YEAR 2014**

Vito D’Amelio respectfully requests the Commission waive the Funding Year 2014 Invoice Deadline Extension rule as codified in the Modernization Order on behalf of Wallington Public Schools District, BEN 122721. During the past year the Wallington School District was forced to abandon one of our primary schools at 32 Pine Street, Wallington, NJ and relocate both students and staff to a leased building and formerly the Most Sacred Heart Catholic School at 6 Bond Street, Wallington, NJ. The abandoned building also contained the offices of our Board of Education, Superintendent’s Office, and Technology Department who have since been relocated to rental trailers on the property of the former school at 32 Pine Street. During this relocation our mail services were disrupted which caused the district’s reimbursement requests to miss the submission deadline.

We respectfully request that the Commission waive the invoice deadline for the following four (4) funding requests.
