**Statement in Support of Petitions for Reconsideration**

By the Chief Information Officer, Bulloch County Schools:

1. Bulloch County Schools (hereinafter “BCS”) presented a petition for waiver to the Commission for the denial of BEAR Invoice Number 2217814 by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) due to being certified by the service Provider, Bulloch County Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc. (hereinafter “Service Provider”) on October 29, 2015, just hours after the funding year 2014 invoice deadline.
2. Through this letter, BCS files its support of the State E-rate Coordinator’s Alliance (hereinafter “SECA”) Petition and of our Service Provider’s petition for waiver of the denial response handed down by the Commission.
