Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 63.1120(e) of the Commission's Rules, this letter provides notification to the Commission of the pending transfer of the Mississippi presubscribed interexchange customers of Bay Springs Communications, Inc. ("Bay Springs") to TEC of Jackson, Inc. ("TEC Jackson"). Bay Springs and TEC Jackson are both wholly-owned subsidiaries of Telephone Electronics Corporation, and both do business as "TEC." Upon finalization of the transaction, TEC Jackson will be providing interexchange services to the former customers of Bay Springs in and around Laurel, Mississippi. The Mississippi Public Utilities Commission approved the proposed transaction on April 5, 2016 (MPSC Docket No. 2016-UA-034).

In accordance with Commission requirements, the following information is submitted herewith:

1. Selling Carrier: Bay Springs Communications, Inc. dba TEC  
Acquiring Carrier: TEC of Jackson, Inc. dba TEC
2. The types of services to be provided to the affected subscribers: intraLATA and interLATA interexchange service.
3. Expected date of transfer of subscriber base: June 30, 2016

A copy of TEC Jackson's advance subscriber notification, mailed on May 15, 2016, is attached. TEC of Jackson, Inc. hereby certifies that it has provided this advance subscriber notice to all affected subscribers in accordance with Section 64.1120(e)(3) of the Commission's Rules, in compliance with the obligations specified in that subsection and with the statutory and Commission requirements applicable to this streamlined notification process.

Dear Valued Customer:

Bay Springs Communications, Inc. (BSCI) and TEC of Jackson, Inc., (TJX) both wholly-owned subsidiaries of Telephone Electronics Corporation and doing business as TEC, are pleased to announce that they have agreed to transfer BSCI's assets, including BSCI's customers, to TJX. The parties anticipate that the transaction will be concluded on or about June 30, 2016. Billing policies will remain the same as they are currently, and the bill presentation will continue to reflect that TEC is the provider.

As of the transfer date, the subscribers of BSCI will become subscribers of TJX unless they have made other arrangements. All services previously received from BSCI will continue without interruption and without any charges to you that result solely from the change in ownership. To the extent that any carrier change charges are associated with this transfer, TJX will pay such charges.


As we complete this process, it is important to us that you fully understand your rights as a consumer. You do have a choice of carriers and have the right to select a different service provider for any or all of the telecommunications services offered – voice service, intrastate and interstate long distance, internet or video – if an alternative carrier is available. Unless you select a different service provider before the transfer date (even if you have arranged for a preferred carrier freeze with BSCI), TJX will continue to provide the voice service, intrastate and interstate long distance, internet or video to you at the rates, and under the same terms and conditions, as those currently offered by BSCI for a period not less than ninety (90) days from the date of transfer of customers. If a subsequent modification in rates, terms or conditions is contemplated, TJX will provide you with at least thirty days' written notice of such increase.

Please note that existing preferred carrier freezes on the service(s) involved in the transfer are automatically lifted unless you select a different carrier before the transfer date. You must contact TEC of Jackson, Inc. to arrange a new freeze.

TJX will become responsible for all service and repair issues as of the date that our transaction closes, and BSCI will continue to respond to any issues or concerns related to the service provided prior to this date. Again, both BSCI and TJX are wholly-owned subsidiaries of Telephone Electronics Corporation and doing business as TEC.
