I respectfully disagree with the petitioner's request to designate CW sub bands as something called "symbol communications", a phrase with no current meaning in Amateur Radio, for various reasons:

1. It makes no sense. Petitioner seeks to invent a phrase which has no current definition or meaning.
2. Exclusive CW sub bands are needed for effective use of that mode of communications, just as Phone sub bands and other mode sub bands are needed to their respective uses. Any person with knowledge of CW knows that interference with other modes is inevitable if the sub bands are changed to allow to exist multiple modes. Effectively, CW will likely cease to exist if that occurs. Or, at the very least, Phone operations will be burdened with CW signals.
3. International rules have traditionally established our existing sub bands and if Petitioner's request is granted, international interference is the only expected result.
4. I am unclear as to the the real intent for Petitioner's request. It appears likely that it is a veiled attempt to request an expansion of the Phone sub bands at the expense of CW operations.
5. There is no need for Petitioner's request. Colloquially, "things are getting along quite nicely" with no need for change.
