**AFFIRMATIVE STATEMENT OF
CONTINUED INTEREST OF TRUE WIRELESS**

True Wireless, LLC (“True Wireless”), by counsel and pursuant to the Wireline Competition Bureau’s May 18, 2016 *Public Notice*,¹ hereby submits this affirmative statement of continued interest in having the Bureau review its pending petition for Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (“ETC”) Designation, and its pending Lifeline Compliance Plan.

On December 22, 2011, True Wireless filed its Petition for designation as an ETC in the states of Alabama, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, New Hampshire, New York, North Carolina, Tennessee, and Virginia. It amended its Petition on March 29, 2012, and again on May 25, 2012, to add a request to be designated in the District of Columbia, as well as reflect changes to the Commission’s Lifeline rules adopted in the 2012 Lifeline Reform Order, and discussions with Bureau staff.

On March 29, 2012, True Wireless filed its original Compliance Plan, and submitted amendments thereto on May 25, 2012, June 1, 2012, October 15, 2012 and December 7, 2012 to reflect discussions with Bureau staff.

Pursuant to the Bureau’s *Public Notice*, True Wireless hereby affirms its continued interest in having the Bureau review its pending ETC Designation Petition and pending Lifeline Compliance Plan as
