**AFFIRMATIVE STATEMENT OF AMERIMEX COMMUNICATIONS CORP.**

AmeriMex Communications Corp. (“AmeriMex”), through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to the Wireline Competition Bureau’s recently released Public Notice,<sup>1</sup> hereby provides its affirmative statement of continued interest in having its pending Petition for Designation as a Low-Income Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (“ETC”) reviewed.<sup>2</sup>

On February 22, 2013, AmeriMex filed its ETC Petition in WC Docket No. 09-197 for limited designation as an ETC in the states of Alabama, Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Florida, New Hampshire, North Carolina, New York, Tennessee, Texas and Virginia.<sup>3</sup>
