
**AFFIRMATIVE STATEMENT OF

Pursuant to the Wireline Competition Bureau ("Bureau") Notice¹ of May 18, 2016, Millennium 2000, Inc. ("Millennium 2000"), by its counsel, provides its Affirmative Statement of continued interest in having its pending Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") Petition reviewed.
