Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Thursday, June 2, Paul Plofchan, VP of Government and Regulatory Affairs for ADT, P. Gray Finney, Senior Vice President and Chief Legal Officer for ADT, Maria DiGiorgio, Senior Legal Counsel for ADT, Hannah Lim, Vice President, Chief Litigation and Chief Compliance Counsel for ADT, and Chris Frazier, Senior Manager, Contact Compliance for ADT, along with Ken Sponsler, Senior Vice President and General Manager of CompliancePoint, and Alex Hecht of ML Strategies, met with Mike Dabbs of the Office of Legislative Affairs and Mark Stone of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau by conference call. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss ways to provide consumers with greater protections under the Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA). Mr. Plofchan and Mr. Sponsler previously discussed these issues with the offices of Chairman Wheeler, Commissioner Pai, and Commissioner O'Reilly.<sup>1</sup>

ADT and CompliancePoint are working alongside other stakeholders, including congressional staff, on policy proposals that incentivize greater business use of compliance programs and clarify vicarious liability provisions under the TCPA.

ADT and Compliance Point appreciate the Commission's expertise on TCPA and look forward to continued engagement with the agency on this issue.
