On June 2, 2016, a demonstration of applications-based delivery of video programming and MVPD services available today in the market was held at the offices of the National Cable & Telecommunications Association (NCTA) for Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel, Marc Paul, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Rosenworcel, and Jennifer Thompson, Special Advisor to Commissioner Rosenworcel. Participating in the demonstration were NCTA's Michael Powell, James Assey, Dane Snowden, Rick Chessen and Neal Goldberg; Neil Fried of the Motion Picture Association of America; Susan Fox of Disney; Jared Sher and Rick Lane of 21st Century Fox; Keith Murphy of Viacom; Anne Lucey of CBS; Mitch Rose of NBCUniversal; Andrew Reinsdorf, Stacy Fuller and Raquel Noriega of AT&T; Jordan Goldstein of Comcast; and Paul Glist of Davis Wright Tremaine LLP.

The demonstrations included apps-delivered programming on Roku, Nvidia, Samsung and Apple TV, DIRECTV service on television sets, and retail devices offering pirated content. The demonstration also included integrated search on Roku of cable and other services. In the course of the demonstration, the participants discussed innovation and competition in apps and in apps-hosting platforms, the ability for diverse programmers to participate in these platforms, and the importance of protecting copyright and addressing piracy, consistent with the comments and reply comments filed in the above-captioned proceedings by the Content Companies (21st Century Fox, Inc., A&E Television Networks, LLC, CBS Corporation, Scripps Networks Interactive, Time Warner Inc., Viacom Inc., and The Walt Disney Company); NCTA; AT&T/DIRECTV; and the Motion Picture Association of America/SAG-AFTRA.
