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I support the privacy regulations in this proceeding. The workers in these out-sourced centers could easily be storing information they should not. I have had my information and identity compromised through the methods of these companies and I am confident I am not the only one. Furthermore, most consumers seem unaware that many of these companies share and sell consumers' information with other companies. It is unfair to allow these companies to share and/or sell this information when the consumers are not specifically requesting this information sharing and informed of all of the applications of the sharing.
