Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 15th, Scott Freiermuth and Mike Ellis with Sprint Corporation ("Sprint") met with Karen Strauss, Eliot Greenwald, Bob Aldrich and Jenny Ludig of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau ("CGB" or "Bureau") as well as Andre Multz of the Office of Managing Director and Bob Loube from Rolka Loube Associates. The purpose of the conversation was to discuss the Internet Protocol Relay ("IP Relay") rate which the TRS Fund Administrator has proposed to reduce from \$1.37 to \$1.2122. Sprint expressed its concerns with this significant rate reduction which impacts Sprint's ability to invest and make improvements to the service. Sprint urged the Bureau to suspend the rate at \$1.37 and to move quickly to restructure IP Relay.
