BPCT-850828KQ) FOR HEARING IN A CONSOLIDATED PROCEEDING, TO BE HELD BEFORE AN ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE AT A TIME AND PLACE TO BE SPECIFIED IN A SUBSEQUENCE ORDER, UPON THE ISSUES SET FORTH THEREIN; THAT THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION IS MADE A PARTY RESPONDENT TO THIS PROCEEDING WITH RESPECT TO ISSUE 3; THAT NANCY SHARP SHALL, WITHIN 20 DAYS AFTER THE RELEASE OF THIS ORDER, FILE WITH THE PRESIDING ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE, A SITE AVAILABILITY CERTIFICATION, IN THE FORM REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSION, OR ADVISE THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE THAT THE CERTIFICATION CANNOT BE MADE AS MAY BE APPROPRIATE; THAT NANCY SHARP SHALL SUBMIT AN AMENDMENT PROVIDING THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SECTION 73.685(F) OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES, TO THE PRESIDING ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE AND A COPY EACH TO THE CHIEF, TV BRANCH, AND THE CHIEF, HEARING BRANCH, MASS MEDIA BUREAU, WITHIN 20 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE RELEASE OF THIS ORDER; THAT LONNY WALTERS PARTNERSHIP SHALL SUBMIT AN AMENDMENT PROVIDING THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SECTION V-C, ITEM 10, FCC FORM 301, TO THE PRESIDING ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE WITHIN 20 DAYS AFTER THIS ORDER IS RELEASED; THAT ANY GRANT OF A CONSTRUCTION PERMIT TO MEREDITH CORPORATION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITION:

IN THE EVENT THAT THE AM STATION PROPOSED BY APPLICATION (BP-850426AC) (720 KHZ, HERNANDO, FLORIDA), BEGINS OPERATING PRIOR TO THE START OF THE TOWER STRUCTURE ERECTION AUTHORIZED HEREIN, THE PERMITTEE SHALL NOTIFY THE AM STATION MAY DETERMINE OPERATING POWER BY THE INDIRECT METHOD AND REQUEST TEMPORARY AUTHORITY FROM THE COMMISSIONS IN WASHINGTON, D.C. TO OPERATE WITH PARAMETERS AT VARIANCE IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN MONITORING POINT FIELD STRENGTHS WITHIN AUTHORIZED LIMITS. PERMITTEE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE INSTALLATION AND CONTINUED MAINTENANCE OF DETUNING APPARATUS NECESSARY TO PREVENT ADVERSE EFFECTS UPON THE RADIATION PATTERN OF THE A.M. STATION. BOTH PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION OF THE TOWER AND SUBSEQUENT TO THE INSTALLATION OF ALL APPURTENANCES THEREON, A PARTIAL PROOF OF PERFORMANCE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 73.154(A) OF THE COMMISSIONS' RULES, SHALL BE CONDUCTED TO ESTABLISH THAT THE A.M. ARRAY HAS NOT BEEN ADVERSELY AFFECTED AND, PRIOR TO OR SIMULTANEOUS WITH THE FILING OF THE APPLICATION FOR LICENSE TO COVER THIS PERMIT, THE RESULTS SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSION; THAT MEREDITH CORPORATION SHALL SUBMIT ITS EXPLANATION FOR ANSWERING "NO" TO SECTION II, ITEM 10, FCC FORM 301, TO THE PRESIDING ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE
