ERRATUM TO COMMENTS OF RADIO TELECOM & TECHNOLOGY INC.

This is an *Erratum* to correct a typographical error in the Comments filed on October 30, 1998, by Radio Telecom & Technology, Inc. ("RTT") in the above-captioned proceeding.

In Paragraph 13 of RTT's Comments, the proposed revision to Section 95.855 of the Rules, governing mobile RTU power limits, should read as follows:

"No RTU that is designed to be used at itinerant locations may transmit with an ERP exceeding 100 milliwatts average power, or 20 watts peak power, whichever is less."

The word "average" (shown as underlined) should be substituted for the word "peak" in the Comments as initially filed.
