The purpose of this letter is to report that on Monday, October 26, 1998, Dean H. Dussias, Vice President, Business to Business Sales, Rand McNally & Company ("RMC") and the undersigned met with representatives of the Commission's General Counsel's Office and the Commercial and Private Wireless Divisions of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.


The meeting focused on these topics:

- (1) The need for an agreement covering the use of RMC's proprietary BTA listings in connection with 39 GHz licensing and payment of license fees under such an agreement as a precondition to the grant of FCC BTA authorizations that make use of 39 GHz spectrum;
- (2) The need for authority from RMC to use its BTA or MTA boundaries for partitioning of licenses in services that are not covered by a licensing agreement with RMC; and

(3) RMC's interest in reaching a broader agreement with the Commission to avoid the need for individual license of the use of RMC's copyrighted Trading Areas by individual FCC-licensed service and licensee.
