This is to advise you that Keith Maydak on August 19, 1998, filed a 402(b) Notice of Appeal, or in the Alternative, 402(a) Petition for Review of : Teleport Communications Group, Inc., Transferor and AT&T Corp., Transferee, For Consent to Transfer of Control of Corporations Holding Point-to-Point Microwave Licenses and Authorizations to Provide International Facilities-Based and Resold Communications Services, CC Docket No. 98-24, FCC 98-169, released July 23, 1998

Keith Maydak petitions for review of the above-referenced order approving a merger between AT&T Corp. and Teleport Communications Group, Inc. Maydak had filed a petition to deny the merger application on public interest grounds and alleges that the Commission was arbitrary and capricious in denying his petition and approving the merger.
